

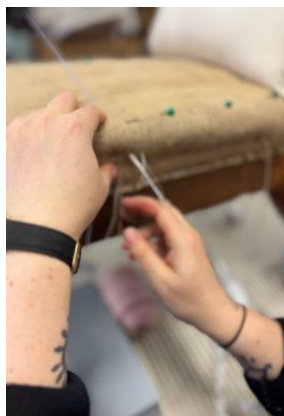


TRADITIONAL HAND SPRUNG CHAIR

A 12-WEEK COURSE IN TRADITIONAL UPHOLSTERY

Sept 17th 2026 – December 17th 2026

Every Thursday for 12 weeks with a half term break. 9.30am to 4.45pm



Traditional Upholstery School has designed this course to provide students with a robust introduction to traditional upholstery. Each student will work on a beautiful chair frame and will build a fully sprung seat and stitched and stuffed shaped back using traditional methods and materials. The chair* is designed by us – and is based on a beautiful original – made in solid beech by our frame-maker in the UK.

This course is unique to Traditional Upholstery School. It will suit beginners wanting a thorough introduction to traditional upholstery skills. It is also designed to suit those who have already made a start, perhaps having completed our Foundation Course, Stage One of the AMUSF diploma or tackled the basics of traditional upholstery on a hobby course.

*The chair frame is the top centre photo. We'll have more images to follow once we have taken delivery.

COURSE CONTENT

This course is a practical workroom-based course with all students working on the same chair. This allows us to teach skills and techniques to a high standard and ensures that everyone finishes their chair by the end of the course. As naturally everyone works at different speeds, it is likely that some students will have some finishing to do at home between sessions.

Skills include: webbing; hand lashing springs, building up a seat pad using edge stitches; learning shape and a good line; tensioning calico and fitting top fabric.

Students may opt to include deep buttoning detail on their chair back.

As well as practical upholstery skills, students will learn chair planning, how to present simple sketches, create a project time plan and cost their project.

Other skills include:

- Health & safety: when working with tools and equipment in a workshop environment
- Appropriate use and care of tools and equipment
- Appropriate care handling of materials in a professional workroom
- Understanding fire safety regulations for furniture.

On successful completion of this one course, students will be able to apply technical knowledge and skills to complex pieces of traditionally upholstered furniture.

WHAT IS PROVIDED

This course includes the chair frame and all the upholstery sundries used. Top fabrics and trimmings are supplied by the student. Hand tools are also provided for use on the day, although students are welcome to bring their own.

COURSE FEES

The full cost of the course is £1,100. This can be paid as a deposit of £300 with the balance paid over three months. We find that this helps our students spread the cost of the course more easily.

We will invoice and send you receipts for all payments. Please see our website for further details on booking terms.
